

ARRIVAL



> Get into the truck only after you have been instructed to do so



> Do not mount the aerial underneath the overhead cables

PREPARING FOR UNLOADING



> Remove wedges and place them in the holders



> Activate suspension: maximum ground clearance

UNLOADING



> Drive off train at walking pace



> Keep a distance of one vehicle length

PLEASE NOTE



> There is a mandatory requirement to wear a high-visibility vest and safety footwear in the terminals, when leaving the train and when loading and unloading the train



> Please follow the instructions of the terminal and railway staff



> Caution: high voltage – danger!



> No other persons or animals are permitted to travel on the train



> Video surveillance



> Use of horn not permitted

PREPARING FOR LOADING



- > Check truck for loose or faulty parts and secure accordingly
- > Secure air deflectors



- > Retract or remove aerials
- > Close and secure tarpaulins
- > Close cistern dome covers
- > Ensure the hazardous materials warning signs are visibly displayed

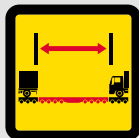
LOADING



- > Activate suspension: maximum ground clearance



- > Drive onto train at walking pace



- > Keep a distance of one vehicle length

LOADING - FINAL STEPS



- > Turn off instruments and electronic devices in the driver's cab



- > Let the air out of the suspension



- > Put handbrake on
- > Retract side mirrors
- > Secure truck with at least four wedges:
 - > NOT at the front on the frontmost axle
 - > NOT between the axles of the tractor
 - > NOT behind the last axle of the trailer

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



- > Drivers are not allowed to stay in their truck during the train journey



- > No smoking anywhere in the passenger carriage



- > Alcohol consumption in terminals and during journey. The alcohol limits are the same as those for road traffic. Drivers may be subject to checks.



- > Open-flame stoves (e.g. camping gas stoves) may not be used or brought on board



- > Do not leave the sleeping car during stops



- > Use the voice communication system in case of emergency
- > Follow loudspeaker announcements
